Reading aloud

- 1) Speak more slowly than you think you need to, especially while you're getting used to it. You will be nervous and read faster anyhow.
- 2) Don't be nervous. People who laugh if you make a mistake should remember that their names are in the cup too!
- 3) Use emphasis. All words don't have equal weight.
- 4) Use pauses.
- 5) Read through ahead of time (if you can) so that you know what you are reading!
