Read Mark 6:31-44.

Imagine that you are one of the people in this crowd. St. Mark says that people were coming to see Jesus in great numbers. You're part of that crowd.

1) Why did you come out to see Jesus?

2) Jesus and His disciples left, apparently without warning. How did you feel when you found out that He was gone?

3) Someone figures out where Jesus was going, and you all rush to get there. How do you get there? Are you with a group of people? What are you talking about as you go?

4) It's late and there's no food, and nowhere near to get food. How do you feel when you notice that you're getting hungry?

5) You're standing close enough to Jesus that you can hear Him talk with His disciples. What do you think He's going to say when they tell Him that the crowd is hungry? What do the disciples look like when Jesus tells them to get food?

6) Jesus has you all sit down in groups. Who's in your group with you? What are you talking about with each other? What does your group think is about to happen?

7) When they start passing out food, what do you see? How do you feel when you realize that there's going to be enough food from five loaves and two fish to feed everyone there?

8) Finally, Jesus sends everyone home. What are you thinking when you wake up the next morning?
