# The Ark of the Covenant



The Ark initially contains the tablets of the Law

Later it has a container of manna and Aaron's staff

Lost at some point, current location unknown

Tent of meeting: Moses would meet with God, and his face shone brightly afterwards: Type of the Transfiguration of Jesus

## Manna in the desert

People are hungry and blame God for sending them out in the desert to die.

God sends food from heaven: flakes that taste as if they're made from honey

People go around asking, "What is it?" -- "Mannah" in Hebrew.

People get to the edge of the Promised Land

Scouts are sent in, and they find well-fortified cities and large people, so they're scared. All of the scouts but two say, "We can't do it."

Exceptions: Caleb and Joshua (who will succeed Moses as leader of the Israelites)

The people won't listen, so God sends them to wander in the wilderness for 40 years.

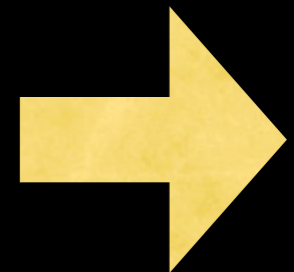
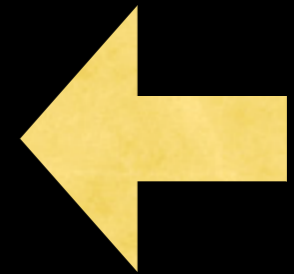
# Summary of 40 years in the wilderness:

People complain

Moses intercedes with God

God gives them relief

People are satisfied--for a bit



Num 21:6-9 Then the LORD sent fiery serpents among the people, and they bit the people, so that many people of Israel died. And the people came to Moses, and said, "We have sinned, for we have spoken against the LORD and against you; pray to the LORD, that he take away the serpents from us." So Moses prayed for the people. And the LORD said to Moses, "Make a fiery serpent, and set it on a pole; and every one who is bitten, when he sees it, shall live." So Moses made a bronze serpent, and set it on a pole; and if a serpent bit any man, he would look at the bronze serpent and live.

John 3:13-15 No one has ascended into heaven but he who descended from heaven, the Son of man. And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of man be lifted up, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life."
